



### **Amazing Urban Race Rules and Regulations**

We have to have them so teams play fair...

1. Although it is not essential, teams are encouraged to wear a unique team outfit – fancy dress is great.
2. Teams can only have a maximum of 5 members, of which 4 team members must attend registration, briefing and get to the finish line together.
3. Teams will not leave Wellington Indoor Sports - Shed 1 until the race director starts the race at approximately 5:00 p.m.
4. Team members must obey traffic, civil and criminal laws at all times.
5. Teams must not consume alcohol or any illegal drugs prior to or during the race.
6. If more than one team is present at a challenge location at the same time, the teams will complete the challenge in the order in which they arrived. The Amazing Urban Race staff reserve the right to delay a team until the previous team has completed the challenge before allowing the next team to begin.
7. During the race teams MAY NOT engage in:
  - Unsportsmanlike or illegal conduct
  - Verbal or physical aggression towards the public, local officials, other participants or the Amazing Urban Race staff
  - Acts of vandalism, theft, (such as stealing signage) or harassment
  - If you do get caught, reported by another team etc. it is very likely your team will be disqualified from the race. This will be at the discretion of the Amazing Urban Race staff. The Amazing Urban Race staff reserve the right to disqualify any participant or team for any reason at any time without refund
8. No repeat photos, only one photo will be accepted for each mission. No combining missions into one photo. For example, taking a picture bowling while hanging upside down will not be counted for both missions, each mission must be a separate photo.

9. While creative interpretations of the items are generally allowed, the judges have the final determination as to whether each photo receives points. Points will be added/deducted as the race progresses meaning your current score may not reflect a recent addition or deduction.

10. Be respectful in everything you do.

11. Teams need to be back at The Green Man Pub by 8:00 p.m. in order to get their food platter!
